



Lesson Information

Ken Dela art lessons are an “independent study” with some friends in the room. Meaning, students can bring a project they are working on in school or at home to the lesson for extra help or create something entirely new. Each student will have one-on-one time with me during the lesson and be assigned a skill to work on throughout the week.

Further, I will be looking for opportunities across the city for students to display their work. Part of being an artist is to induce a reaction from others, we will work on this in class and hopefully find some spaces where students can experience this setting which can be very rewarding.

Small-Group Lessons:

- No more than four students will be in each small group class. Each student will learn art techniques customized to their skill set and interests. They can work on their own individual projects or learn a new technique with the group depending on the situation.
- If a student signs up after the Spring session begins the payments will be prorated based on the student's registration date.
- The tuition costs include all supplies.
- **Price: \$120 every 4 weeks**

Private lessons:

- Private lessons are one on one and the lesson block will be blocked from having any other students join.
- Private lessons are only available upon request and can only be on a day/time where there are no other students already enrolled in that time slot.
- The tuition costs include all supplies except for the student's sketchbooks used for their weekly assignments.
- **Price: \$240 every 4 weeks**
